**Position Summary:** Under the supervision of the Environmental Program Manager, the Water Specialist will participate in the planning and establishment of the Tribe's water pollution control program under the EPA CWA 106 and GAP grants. The Tribe's water pollution control program will include quality assurance and water quality monitoring program, field investigations, ground and surface water data collection, outreach activities and coordination with local agencies.

**A qualified candidate will:** Assist in planning, documenting and carrying out specific projects to implement the ENR Plan in accordance with applicable codes, regulations and the US EPA 106 GAP Grant work plan. Conduct research, collect and organize all existing data pertaining to the Tribe's water resources. Start groundwater, surface water and stream flow assessments. Conduct wetland assessment and protection. Conduct non-point source control activities including assessment and creation, revision and implementation of management plan. Conduct research, collect, organize and refine data for reports and surveys. Assist in developing a Quality Assurance Program Plan for ground and surface water assessments. Prepare and manage a variety of files, reports and records. Assist Environmental Manager in gathering water quality information. Develop materials and participate in outreach regarding water resources for the Tribal Youth Education and Community.

**Qualifications must include:** Possess High School Diploma or GED. Experience required in related field, or college education preferred. Possess good communication skills, both oral and written, including statistical/technical reporting and report writing. Be computer literate in Windows, MS Word, Excell and e-mail/internet. Possess knowledge of safe work methods and safety precautions as relate to the job. Ability to walk, stand, kneel, crawl, climb, lift and move up to 75 pounds, pull, stoop, bend, squat, twist, turn and work in tight, confined spaces. Possess valid California Driver License and maintain current vehicle insurance. **Must provide a DMV printout.**
