



In Search of Project Provider- Native Art Instructor

The Tuolumne Me-Wuk Tribal TANF Program (TMWTT) is requesting quotes (RFQ) from qualified project providers to provide a cultural education and preservation program for TMWTT participants. The (RFQ) should focus on preserving, strengthening, while renewing cultural practices and values. The (RFQ) should be prepared simply and providing a straightforward, concise description of the proposer's capabilities to satisfy the requirements.

The Project Providers will be providing a quote for: *Native Art Instructor* can be held either thru Zoom conferencing or "in person" at the TMWTT office(s) in Sonora, Modesto and at a Calaveras location. ZOOM will be held two times (2xs) a week / "In person" will be held one time (1x) a week per location. Classes will be held from 4:30pm-6:30pm via ZOOM/ 5:00pm-7:00pm "in person".

(RFQ) applications can be submitted until: **Filled**

Proposal should include, but not limited to:

- Cost per "in person" class: prepare for forty attendees per week, per location (youth and adults). Cost per ZOOM class: 2xs a week.
- Cost for Fuel mileage at \$0.575 per mile. (MapQuest from home of address to the 3 TMWTT location or ZOOM location).
- Cost for supplies needed (must provide supplies list needed)
- Must submit proof of competency and knowledge of *Native Art*.

The successful Project Provider will be required to enter into a contract with TMWTT for the length of the proposal and consent to a background check.
