The Tuolumne Me-Wuk Tribal TANF Program (TMWTT) is requesting for quotes (RFQ) from qualified project providers to provide a cultural education program for TMWTT participants. The focus should be strengthening, and/or renewing cultural practices and values. The bid should be prepared simply, and provide a straightforward, concise description of the proposer's capabilities to satisfy the requirements.

The Project Providers will be providing a quote for ***Native Games & History Instructor***. Classes can be held either through Zoom conferencing or in person at the TMWTT office(s) in Sonora, Modesto and our Calaveras location. ZOOM will be held two times (2xs) a week / "in person" will be held one time (1x) a week per location. Classes will be held weekly from 4:30pm-7:30pm via ZOOM / 4:30pm-7:30pm "in person".

RFQs can be submitted until: **Filled**

Proposals should include, but are not limited to:

- Cost per "in person" class: prepare for forty attendees per week, per location (youth and adults). Cost per ZOOM class: 2xs a week.
- Cost for Fuel mileage at \$0.56 per mile. (MapQuest from home of address to the 3 TMWTT location).
- Cost for supplies needed (must provide supplies list needed)
- Must submit proof of competency and knowledge of ***Native Games & History***.

The successful Project Provider will be required to enter into a contract with TMWTT for the length of the proposal and consent to a background check. This contract is subject to cancellation by TMWTT or the Project Provider.
